This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY NEAR BAKER FROM 1.9 KM WEST OF EAST BAKER OVERCROSSING TO 0.6 KM EAST OF CIMA ROAD OVERCROSSING.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on May 23, 2002.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

In the Special Provisions, Section 5-1.19.5, "RELATIONS WITH THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS," is added as attached.

In the Special Provisions, Section 11, "MODIFIED STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS SECTIONS," the first paragraph of Section 39-8.02, "PRIME COAT AND PAINT BINDER (TACK COAT)," is revised to read:

"A prime coat of asphaltic emulsion SS1, shall be applied to the areas to be surfaced."

To Proposal and Contract book holders:

5-1.19.5 RELATIONS WITH THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS

A portion of this project is located within the jurisdiction of the United States Army Corps of Engineers. An agreement has been entered into by the Department of Transportation and the United States Army Corps of Engineers. The Contractor shall fully conform to the requirements of this agreement as well as all rules, regulations, and conditions that may govern the construction operations.

Copies of the agreement may be obtained at the Department of Transportation, Plans and Bid Documents Section, MS 26, 1120 N Street, Room 200, Sacramento, CA 95814, Telephone 916-654-4490, and are available for inspection at the Department of Transportation, District 08, Environmental Technical Branch, 464 West Fourth Street, San Bernardino, California 92401-1400, Telephone (909) 383-4561.

Any modifications to the agreement between the Department of Transportation and the United States Army Corps of Engineers which are proposed by the Contractor shall be submitted in writing to the Engineer for transmittal to the United States Army Corps of Engineers for consideration.

When the Contractor is notified by the Engineer that a modification to the agreement is under consideration, no work will be allowed which is inconsistent with the proposed modification until the Department and the United States Army Corps of Engineers take action on the proposed modifications. Compensation for delay will be determined in accordance with Section 8-1.09, "Right of Way Delays," of the Standard Specifications.

The provisions of this section shall be made a part of every subcontract executed pursuant to this contract.

Any modifications to any agreement between the Department of Transportation and the United States Army Corps of Engineers will be fully binding on the Contractor, and the provisions of this section shall be made a part of every subcontract executed pursuant to this contract.
