The Bay Area Air Quality Management District is pleased to submit the attached pilot project ideas for inclusion in the California Sustainable Freight Action Plan. Three of the four pilot projects focus on reducing emissions of criteria pollutants and greenhouse gases from ocean going vessels by improving fuel economy while underway or controlling emissions while vessels are at berth. The fourth pilot project will expand the use of bicycles for local deliveries. Individually and collectively these projects will further the state's goals of improved local health, achievement of the State and Federal ambient air quality standards, freight efficiency, economic competitiveness and transitioning to zero-emission technologies.

These pilot projects are in addition to the ones submit jointly with our regional and local partners as part of the Bay Area Goods Movement Plan development.
