RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolution R-3468 - R3470 and R3472.

The local agency will be accepting a lump sum payment to satisfy the States obligation to place the highway in a state of good repair. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described by the individual summary.

R-3468 – 06-Fre-168,180-PM R0.0/R0.8,R58.4/R61.0 (Request No. 83733) – 30 Segments
Relinquishes right of way in the City of Fresno, between Belmont Avenue to Clinton Avenue and State Route 41 to Garden Avenue, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city streets, frontage roads and cul-de-sacs. Project accepted on July 14, 1999. The City by cooperative agreement dated May 23, 2000, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3469 – 06-Fre-168-PM 0.4/2.0 (Request No. 84116) – 1 Segment
Relinquishes right of way in the City of Fresno, between State Route 41 and Cedar Avenue, consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment. Project accepted on April 6, 1999. The City by cooperative agreement dated April 25, 2000, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3470 – 06-Ker-204-PM 6.5 (Request No. 82366) – 2 Segments
Relinquishes right of way in the City of Bakersfield, at Pierce Road, consisting of reconstructed city street connections. Project accepted on January 20, 1995. The City by resolution dated August 7, 1996, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3472 – 7-LA-39-PM 11.6/13.1 (Request No. 1196B) – 1 Segment
Relinquishes a portion of Route 39 right of way in the City of Covina, from 0.1 mile south of Badillo Street to Arrow Highway, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Assembly Bill No. 2909, Chapter 596 Statutes of 2000 which amended Section 339 of the Streets and Highways Code.
